100 YEARS STRONG

AIR AND SPACE POWER TO PROTECT OUR NATION

For over a hundred years the Royal Air Force has defended the skies of Britain and projected Britain's power and influence around the world.

The Royal Air Force was formed in April 1918 as a separate Service, independent of the British Army and Royal Navy – the first time that any country had done this.

The story of the RAF is full of iconic aircraft that have played major roles in the shaping of our history.

[Tiger Moth](#) planes were introduced in 1931, a classic British design that is still used around the world today.

The most famous plane is the [Spitfire](#), introduced in 1935. It became one of the most successful fighter aircraft ever built and played a pivotal role in the Battle of Britain.

The triumph of the Dambusters raid in 1943 was based on specially modified [Lancaster](#) bombers, executing arguably the most daring air raid of World War II.

The now world-famous [Red Arrows](#) first appeared in 1965, and are recognised for the outstanding contribution they have made to British prestige in the field of aviation.

In 1969, the world's first vertical take-off and landing aircraft, the [Harrier](#), arrived and it was to play a vital role in the Falklands conflict in 1982.

The [Typhoon FGR4](#) came in 2008. A swing-role combat aircraft with excellent agility at all speeds. They provide Quick Reaction Alert UK air defence.

[F-35B Lightning](#) stealth combat aircraft now provide the ability to project air power from the land or sea.

The [Chinook Mk 6](#), introduced in 2014, is increasingly the RAF workhorse. It can hold a position very accurately due to a unique Digital Automatic Flight Control System.

Looking forward, the Royal Air Force remains at the heart of the Government's approach to conflict and crisis management.

FOUNDED IN 1956, ICARUS FC COMPRISES CURRENT AND FORMER SERVING RAF OFFICERS.

While not active in weekly league competition, the Club currently competes in 3 AFA cup competitions in the London area, against the other Services and the academies of professional clubs.

The Club also has an active Vets team and in total plays over 40 fixtures a season including an annual overseas visit which over recent seasons has included the Netherlands, Germany, USA, Cyprus, Denmark, Bulgaria, Guernsey and Gibraltar.


In the RAF's 100th anniversary there is undoubtedly extra pressure for Icarus FC to do well, and they have risen to the challenge this year, highlighted with their 3-2 victory in the AFA Middlesex & Essex Intermediate Cup Final in April.

Two Icarus players, Ben Burton and Ryan Bradshaw (shown right) were also part of the RAF Coningsby team that won the RAF Cup at Vicarage Road in May.

Icarus also started the 2018-19 season in style, getting one over the Army in a hard-fought cup final that the Icarus boys won on penalties.

In September, Icarus paid an extended visit to Sofia, Bulgaria to play games against local sides including the Bulgarian armed forces and CSKA Sofia U-19's. The tour also included community projects and a youth sporting day.


We look forward to a challenging game today as part of RAF 100 & WWI Armistice events.





Mark Mellor, a referee who has been a long time friend of Oxhey Jets, had this personal story to tell about Armistice Day 1918.

“In researching my family history we found out that my Great, Great, Maternal Grandmother's Brother died on November 11th 1918, the very last day of World War I while serving in the British Army in Northern Greece. We learnt that he is buried in a small British Military Cemetery in a village called Exochi which is located just outside of Thessaloniki. Another thing we had found out was that his headstone had the name of "Private M Scully". Knowing that his name was Matthew, set us on a mission to travel out to Greece and make sure his final resting place had some formal recognition of his full name -the least he deserved having paid the ultimate price for his country.

We found the cemetery, the land being ‘the free gift of the Greek people for the perpetual resting place of those of the Allied Armies who fell in the War of 1914 - 1918 and are Honoured here’. We took with us, a Poppy, a 50 pence coin which commemorated the war, and a dog tag we had made with Matthews name on it.

It was very humbling to walk amongst the Headstones, especially when you see the ages of the young men who lost their lives and think about your own family safely back at home. We located Matthew's grave which was at the end of a row near to the boundary edge. Immaculately kept, like the rest of the site, I sat down and tried to imagine the horror that everybody in my eye line had witnessed. It was impossible to do so in the bright and warm September sunshine, but I still kissed his Headstone and said my thanks. I placed the Poppy, Coin and Tag at the foot of his grave.

I am not ashamed to say that I also shed a few tears as I walked away taking with me my memories but leaving behind my heartfelt thanks as I left him and his colleagues to "Rest In Peace".

OXHEY JETS FC CLUB HISTORY

- Jets were founded in 1972 by current General Manager John Elliott
- The team had grown out of the 2nd Oxhey Boys Brigade Team.
- Jets were entered into the South West Herts League under-12's.
- Jets won the League Cup Final in their first season.
- More youth sides were added in the following seasons.
- In 1978-79, the original side grew out of the youth leagues, so they joined the Watford Men's Saturday League, winning Division One in their first year without dropping a point.
- In 1979-80 Jets progressed to the West Herts League and became the first Oxhey side to win the Watford Peace Memorial Shield.

EARLY YEARS

1981-2000

- Jets progressed again and joined the Herts Senior County League Division One in 1981
- Jets gained promotion to the Premier Division in 1983.
- Throughout the time in the Herts Senior County League, Jets were NEVER relegated.
- Jets next big step forward was the development of the current £2m complex in Altham Way, a design built almost to Ryman's League standards, giving the club the opportunity to grow in the 21st century.

HERTS SENIOR COUNTY LEAGUE

2000-03



The move to Altham Way transformed the club and came at the same time as the Jets team were hitting new heights. In 2000-01 the Club was Herts Senior County League Champions, they won it again the following year along with the Aubrey Cup & Herts Senior Charity County Cup. In 2002-03 they retained them all and added the Rickmansworth Charity Cup.

2003-04



2003-04 was an exceptional season with Jets gaining promotion to the Spartan South Midlands League, & winning the St. Marys and Rickmansworth Charity Cups.

2004-05



2004-05 was a fantastic season with Jets winning Spartan Division 1 at the first go, along with cup wins in the Herts Centenary Trophy & Minerva Floodlight Cup.

2005-06



2005-06 is remembered for being the first year that we qualified to enter the F.A. Cup following our promotion to the Spartan South Midlands Premier. That achievement was, however, surpassed by playing, and winning, our first fixture against football league opponents, beating Barnet 2-1 in what is still regarded as the club's greatest game.

2006-07



Following on from the previous year's success over Barnet, Jets scored an equally impressive 4-1 Herts Senior Cup win over St. Albans.

2006-07



Jets had some good cup victories on the way to meeting AFC Wimbledon, none more so than a 1-0 win away win at higher league Aveley with this 25-yard free-kick strike.

2006-07



Jets had their best F.A. Cup campaign in 2006-07, finally losing away at AFC Wimbledon. Despite the defeat, we all spent an unforgettable day. We also had a good run in the F.A. Vase before losing at Ipswich Wanderer, and did some more giant killing in the Herts Senior Cup, beating high flying St. Albans City 4-1.
